The Club committee invites you to play for the Pine Hills Football Club in the 2012 season.

If you know anyone who was not at the club last year and who might be interested in playing senior football with Pine Hills in 2012 please forward this information to them.

2012 REGISTRATION PROCESS:

All players must register online at <http://www.myfootballclub.com.au>. It is a simple process and registration can be paid online by credit card during the online registration process if you are paying in full. If not, print the tax invoice at the end of the process and bring to the club to pay. Please refer to the attached document PHFC - MFC Online registration guidelines, which is also available on the website www.pinehillsfootball.com

It is a requirement of Football Queensland that all players are registered before taking the field for any matches, including pre-season trials. This means all players playing in the Pine Hills Pre-Season Competition commencing on 21 January 2012 will need to register by then.

2012 REGISTRATION COSTS:

The club has attempted to keep registration fees at the same price as 2010 and 2011 however a late increase in fees from Football Brisbane of \$5, and a decision to introduce a fundraising levy in 2012 has made it necessary to increase the fees by \$20.

ALL FEES ARE TO BE SETTLED IN FULL WHEN REGISTERING OR paid BY INSTALMENTS AS PER THE FEES POLICY to be eligible to play.

PAYING BY INSTALMENTS AS PER THE PHFC FEES POLICY:

- The PHFC Fees Policy allows for players to pay their fees by instalments. A player must sign an agreement to pay the instalments by nominated dates.
- Failure to pay the instalments in full by Sunday 18 March 2012 will mean that the player will not be able to take the field until such time as the balance of fees has been paid. **The club does not enforce this rule to discriminate against anyone; we do not enjoy telling a player that they cannot play.** This is an **administrative issue to alleviate the long hours of work for unpaid volunteers to chase and process payments and registrations.** Please respect the volunteers who assist at the club by making payments in the timeframes outlined. If you cannot make the payments within these timeframes, please contact Jenny Baddeley (Treasurer) to seek approval for an alternative payment plan.
- The initial payment covers the Football Brisbane registration and insurance and the balance can then be paid off in another two instalments.

DRESS CODE POLICY:

Game Day: Plain black shorts with Q-Logo, black socks and club jersey. Shorts and socks are available at sign-on or any time from the office.

Players must not wear the training strip shorts in any match played, if the club incurs a fine it will be passed on to the offending player/s.

Off Field: All Senior players are required to wear the black club shirt to games.

Training: **Players must wear the Pine Hills club training strips at all training sessions.**

These training strips are to be worn as purchased, and must not be altered in any way. (i.e. Names or numbers are not permitted anywhere on the outside of the shirt or shorts.)
