Games to watch are:

Metro 2 on Friday night at Wolter Park. The team is sitting in top position after Friday night's 9-0 defeat of North Pine (and Redlands going down to Rochedale Rovers 2-1) and hope to take out the top spot this season.

NCSL Over 35s are safely tucked into 3rd place on the ladder after Friday night fixtures and they are at home next Friday, taking on Northern who are in 5th spot.

The Div 1 women are up against University of Queensland on Saturday evening. They've had tough competition this season but continue to play good solid football.

The Youth Div 1 team is at home on Saturday afternoon against North Pine as the curtain raiser for the Premier League matches. They take on North Pine in what should be a hard fought match between two north side rivals.

The Premier Leagues reserves side should have a close game against South with only a point or two between them on the ladder. The last time they came together Pine Hills went down 4-1, so they'll be looking to improve on that score.

The Premier League drew with Souths 1-1 when they took them on in the first round, good luck to the team to bring it home on Saturday.

The Met 6 boys won't be watching the Premier League games; they'll be at McCook Park taking on Newmarket. Met 6 are sitting comfortable in second position after defeating 3rd placed Holland Park Hawk"ies" at home on Friday night 6-3. A win against Newmarket won't see them contesting first place, but it will give them what they need to take on the Hawks in the semi final the following week.

Youth Div 3 and Metro 5 are both at home in a double header on Sunday afternoon, with the Youth team taking on Moggill, and Met 5 are up against University of Qld. The Met 5 boys win against second placed Toowong on Friday night sees them in the top four and they look like they need this win to keep their spot. Should be a good hard fought game, and worthy of a trip down to the club on Sunday afternoon.

The Div 5 women are away on Sunday afternoon at Dittmer Park, playing third placed Mount Gravatt and this will be a tough match for them as Mount Gravatt will be looking to improve their position in the top four.
